

MORE EX. EURL-CAMPYLOBACTER ACTIVITIES SINCE LAST WORKSHOP

- Analytical methods for example:
- Evaluation of methods do identify and distinguish between *C. upsaliensis/C. helveticus*
- Campylobacter survival on chicken skin in different temperatures over time
- Participated in WG-Whole genome sequencing survey in May
- Participated in ISO/CEN activities (ISO/SC9/WG4 and CEN/WG6/TAG3)
- Guidance document for NRLs on outsourcing parts of PT (EURLs: Listeria monocytogenes, Salmonella, VTEC and Campylobacter)

NOT ON THE PROGRAM THIS YEAR

A microbiological criterion - **process hygiene criterion** (PHC) for *Campylobacter* was included in **Regulation (EC) No 2073/2005** in 2017- should be applied from 1st of January 2018

- The implementation, in practical terms, seems to vary between countries
- Too little experience yet and therefore too early to make conclusions on implementation
